Interview:

A time to meet, share concerns, your vision of prenatal care and birth, our expectations, our practice and style, answer questions and decide whether or not to work together

Initial Visit:

- Full physical exam offered
- Health and family history taken Blood drawn for complete prenatal panel workup
- Information given on health habits, nutrition, and exercise
- Packet of hiring and legal/fees paperwork given including diet diary
- Prenatal exam:

blood pressure pulse urine dipstick to test for protein and glucose fetal heart rate (after 12 weeks with Doppler, after 20 weeks with fetascope) weight fundal height (height of uterus) position of baby determined discussion about diet time to talk, ask questions, voice concerns, get to know each other!

Monthly Visit until 28 weeks:

• Prenatal exam:

blood pressure pulse urine dipstick to test for protein and glucose fetal heart rate (after 12 weeks with Doppler, after 20 weeks with fetascope) weight fundal height (height of uterus) position of baby determined discussion about diet time to talk, ask questions, voice concerns, get to know each other!

28 Week Visit:

- recheck hematocrit and hemoglobin
- glucose screen (if chosen)
- prenatal RhoGAM (if chosen)
- Prenatal exam:

blood pressure pulse urine dipstick to test for protein and glucose fetal heart rate (after 12 weeks with Doppler, after 20 weeks with fetascope) weight fundal height (height of uterus) position of baby determined discussion about diet time to talk, ask questions, voice concerns, get to know each other!

28 -35 Week Visits:

- childbirth classes planned
- gathering birth supplies, purchasing birth kit

- supplies should be ready

 - time to talk, ask questions, voice concerns, get to know each other!
